It's me, Sean Hillwig, giving you the most updated messages about service.

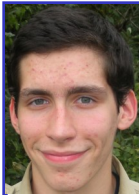
The past ordeal was a huge success. We carted over THREE THOUSAND bricks across camp, hauled all the cots to Maintenance, and cleaning all

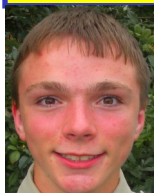
